
AVS/031/001 AV/VC Intro - Column (inc. Back panel)



VESA fixing kit












INTERNAL EQUIPMENT SPACE


- Safe installation of electrical equipment is the responsibility of the installer.







FIX SCREEN MOUNT TO SCREEN






SELECT SCREEN MOUNTING HEIGHT





2.3 INSTALL SCREEN AND SCREEN MOUNT







SECURE SCREEN MOUNT TO COLUMN

Ensure all 4 screws are fully tightened




2.5 INSTALL SCREEN CABLES INTO CABLE HOOK







FEED CABLES PAST EQUIPMENT BASKET AND PLACE EQUIPMENT INTO POSITION



PASS EQUIPMENT CABLES THROUGH THE CABLE MANAGEMENT HOLE IN THE BASE








CLOSE BACK PANEL
